Trinity Sunday is a Christian feast dedicated to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity, the essence of God expressing itself in three persons: *God the Father, Jesus Christ the Son,* and the *Holy Spirit, the Spirit of God.* It is one of the few Christian feasts that celebrates a doctrine, not an event. In Western Christianity Trinity Sunday always falls on the Sunday after <u>Pentecost</u>. In Eastern Christianity <u>Pentecost Sunday</u> itself is Trinity Sunday.
